Age Groups and Weight classes *2kg allowance*

Masters

SENIOR: 20 + years of age (born in 2003 and older). Any athlete over 40 years old must provide a medical certificate that states that they are physically able to compete.

WOMEN (WW): 50, 53, 55, 57, 59, 62, 65, 68, 72, 76, 83 kg

MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS): 57, 61, 65, 70, 74, 79, 86, 92, 97, 125 kg

U20-JUNIOR: 18 to 20 years of age (born in 2004, 2005, 2006) Athletes from 17 years of age (born 2007 and older) may compete in Junior competition, however parental authorization and a medical certificate are required.

WOMEN (WW): 50, 53, 55, 57, 59, 62, 65, 68, 72, 76, 83 kg

MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS): 57, 61, 65, 70, 74, 79, 86, 92, 97, 125 kg

U19: 17-18 years of age (born in 2006, 2007)

WOMEN (WW): 36-40, 43, 46, 49, 53, 57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 80, 90 kg

MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS): 39-42, 45, 48, 51, 55, 60, 65, 71, 80, 92, 110, 125 kg

U17: 15-16 years of age (born in 2008, 2009)

WOMEN (WW): 36-40, 43, 46, 49, 53, 57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 80, 90 kg

MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS): 39-42, 45, 48, 51, 55, 60, 65, 71, 80, 92, 110, 125 kg

U15: 13-14 years of age (born in 2010, 2011)

WOMEN (WW): 33, 36, 39, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62, 66, 70, 80 kg

MEN'S FREESTYLE (FS): 34, 38, 41, 44, 48, 52, 57, 62, 68, 75, 85, 100 kg

Rules: Competition rules will be in accordance with the most recent WCL Rulebook including any UWW Modifications. Athletes may wear a red/blue singlet in accordance with WCL rules or a team/club singlet.

Medical Services: Event Medical Personnel will be in attendance. Any athletes who require preventative therapy is required to bring their own supplies.

Eligibility: All participating athletes, coaches and officials must be members in good standing with Saskatchewan Amateur Wrestling Association or their Prov. Association. All coaches who wish to be Mat side will need to register and be approved.

Medal Presentations: Medals will be presented at the end of each competitive section outlined above.
